



Dundee Profile

Dundee, on the east coast of Scotland, is known for its rich industrial heritage, vibrant cultural scene, and stunning location along the River Tay. With two universities and in 2023/24 had nearly 4,000 international students from a diverse range of backgrounds.

Friends International has worked in Dundee for over 30 years, offering a wide range of activities that provide a Christian welcome, hospitality, community involvement, friendship, and evangelistic Bible studies for people of all religious backgrounds.

We also train Christian international students for cross-cultural outreach, equipping them as disciples who will serve in the global church. This work is carried out in partnership with local churches, Christian Unions, and a strong team of experienced volunteers.

From February 2026, Nathan Forbes will be the sole staff member in Dundee and Friends International is seeking to recruit a Team Leader to work with Nathan, the local volunteer team, the Dundee Branch and local churches .

This role fulfils Friends International's mission in the city to work with the church to communicate the good news of Jesus to international students in both word and deed and in whole life cross-cultural discipleship.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Developing partnerships with local churches and Christian Unions
- Liaising with university staff
- Maintaining and developing the programme of activities
- Leading the staff and volunteer team and supervising any other staff in Dundee
- Working with the Friends International Dundee Branch

The post currently involves some work at weekends and evening work since our activities are at times when students and volunteers are available. It includes administrative work and communication with students through social media.
