Bingham Academy is located in the Ethiopian capital of Addis Ababa. With nearly five million people, Addis Ababa is the largest city in the Horn of Africa and hosts the African Union Headquarters, the United Nations Economic Commission for Africa and nearly one hundred foreign embassies. Bingham's 320 students in K-12 come from over 20 countries. The faculty currently represents Ethiopia, the United States of America, Australia, England, South Africa, South Korea, New Zealand, Scotland and Northern Ireland. Bingham Academy was established to meet the educational needs of missionary children and the majority of our students continue to be children of missionaries or Christians serving the people of Ethiopia. The remainder of our students come from the wider expatriate community in Addis Ababa.

Accreditation & Curriculum

Bingham Academy is accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) and Middle States Association (MSA). Our school is also a member of the Association of International Schools in Africa (AISA). We teach the Cambridge International Examinations Curriculum from Kindergarten through to Grade 12 which prepares students for the Cambridge IGCSE and A Level examinations. Cambridge International Examinations results are accepted for university entrance around the world and, in some cases, with advanced standing.

Course Load & Expectations for staff

Full-time teachers are normally expected to teach a 20 period course load (which equates to 20 contact hours). In the Secondary School this would represent 4 or 5 classes. Teachers are also expected to participate in staff devotions, school chapels, playground supervisions and extra-curricular activities. Teaching at Bingham Academy is a great opportunity to educate motivated students and to make an impact on them and their families for God's glory.

CONFIRMING PLACEMENT

- * Completion of a criminal record check with no results that would preclude working with children
- * Evidence of medical fitness for service in Ethiopia
