



EXPLORE MISSIONS TEACH ENGLISH THAILAND

20 - 30 January 2027



Join a **World Outreach International** team to teach English in schools and communities in rural Thailand.

Our first few days will include cultural orientation and briefing, meeting some of our mission partners around Bangkok, and preparing for English teaching.

Whilst English is our focus, we expect to participate in other outreach activities such as ministry to children, youth remand centre, and visits to missions partners around Bangkok.



Our journey starts in **Bangkok** where we'll spend time going through **cultural briefings, team building, and child safety protocols**. We'll visit World Outreach mission partners and learn about their work.

English teaching will be in **Rayong**, a coastal province south of Bangkok. This is a rare opportunity to travel off the tourist trail and share life with local people.

Dress requirements are quite specific and will be explained in team preparation meetings.

Our **accommodation** is generally small hotels and guesthouses. It's the coolest time of the year in Thailand and, although it will be warm, you'll find the **temperature** to be quite comfortable and air con is usually available in our accommodation.

We'll be **eating** Thai food, of course, and it's a mix of mild to spicy food. Food allergies need to be advised when applying. There will be time each day to talk through our learning and hear God together through **team devotions**.

COST

Approx GBP970 per person **shared** room for 11 days|10 nights.

Single room may be available; additional cost to be confirmed.

Includes shared simple accommodation, meals, transport, gifts to our hosts, and planned activities. Tourist activities will be extra.

Airfares to Thailand passports, vaccinations etc at your own cost.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Check with your doctor regarding immunisations. We don't expect to be travelling in malarial zones.

TRAVEL INSURANCE IS MANDATORY and must cover COVID medical and hospital care.

Mask wearing in schools is not currently required however this could change.

WHO CAN COME

People of all age, learners, leaders, and anyone passionate about seeing the kingdom of God advanced. Children over 10 years old also welcome with a parent. Inquiries now open.

All adults will be required to complete an application, provide references, and complete a police clearance or similar.

HOW TO GET THERE

You will be given guidance on suggested travel to Thailand, and you may choose to make your own arrangements and meet the team in Bangkok.

Plan to arrive by 19 January and leave after 30 January.

Accommodation can be booked for you, if required.
