## Job Responsibilities

---

### 1. To contribute to the operation of the Watersports Centre

- Understanding and abiding by the Watersports Centre Operating Procedures.
- Ensure that guests experience, a safe, enjoyable and well organised experience of the Watersports centre.
- Running the Watersports Centre on a rota system, and constantly being aware of the safety of guests, and that they are being looked after and well served.
- Working under the Watersports Centre Manager and Assistant Manager to have a professional, guest focused approach, serving the guest experience in valuing every guest that wants to engage in the watersports offered.
- Helping to coach and develop fellow waterfront instructors and Fast Trackers
- Ensure that kit is well looked after and maintained, undertaking simple repair jobs as instructed by the waterfront manager.
- Running courses and sessions within your qualifications and capabilities.

### 2. Commitment to Faith, Team and Guests

- Join in with life in resort including being involved with evening and daytime entertainments as required and dealing with guest inquires and queries where possible, remembering that even in “down time” you are representing Richmond.
- Take regular personal times of prayer and bible study in order to maintain a living and active relationship with God, as well as contributing to team bible studies and encouraging others in their faith.
- Undertake any other roles or duties deemed necessary for the smooth running of the resort
