## Job Description

---

As a Richmond Youth Worker, you are responsible for creating an open and welcoming culture for all youth who holiday with Richmond by providing a space where youth are free to explore their faith, make friendships and have fun by engaging in activities on their holidays.

You will assist the resort team to deliver excellent service, including contributions to activities and entertainments for all ages on and off-site.

As the role involves leading youth ministry, prayer and bible-based input, there is a general occupational requirement that you are a strong committed Christian with an active faith.

## Job Responsibilities

---

### 1. To lead Youth work for Richmond Guests in our Samos resort

- Plan an engaging and structured itinerary each week of free-to-participate in activities, making use of the brilliant resort setting, tailored to the youth ages (12-17)
- Create and maintain all key paperwork, from timetables to sign up sheets, consent forms and registers, risk assessments
- Create robust sign in and out systems, working within clear ratios and taking responsibility for all kids and youth in our care
- Play a key part in the welcome meeting, liaising with parents, taking sign-ups and communicating with clarity to parents what the offering is for the week.
- Run afternoon all age activities and evening entertainments on a rota basis
- Prepare an outstanding series of evening ministry with at least two weeks of content
- Pay close attention to the needs of the youth, ensuring all of them are involved in some way and are having an excellent holiday experience, this may involve discussion with their parents as to what they want or need
- Ensure the youth areas are tidy, safe and fun place for the youth to come to each day
- Plan ahead to make use of the Youth budgets in close consultation with the Resort Manager and other Youth Team members
- To understand and work within our Safeguarding Policy and reporting methods
- Working closely with the Watersports Centre's Manager and Resort Reps to coordinate watersport activity slots and throughout resort to allow for smooth running of activities.

## **2. Commitment to Faith, Team and Guests**

- Join in with life in resort including being involved with evening and daytime entertainments as required and dealing with guest inquires and queries where possible, remembering that even in “down time” you are representing Richmond.
- Take regular personal times of prayer and bible study in order to maintain a living and active relationship with God, as well as contributing to team bible studies and encouraging others in their faith.
- Undertake any other roles or duties deemed necessary for the smooth running of the resort
- Encourage, support, and actively contribute to a thriving culture of peer-support and Christian community within the Richmond team.in with life in resort including being involved with evening and daytime entertainments as required and dealing with guest inquires and queries where possible, remembering that even in “down time” you are representing Richmond.
