- In addition to teaching voice techniques, notation, and rhythm, the role includes preparing students for internal and external exams such as ABRSM or Trinity.
- As part of our boarding school community, the teacher will also be involved in dormitory responsibilities and Christian activities.

- To prepare students for internal assessments and external exams (e.g., ABRSM, Trinity).

- Familiarity with music examination systems such as ABRSM or Trinity (Preferred)
