

Stirling Profile

Stirling is a small city in central Scotland and on the edge of the Scottish Highlands, famous for its history, medieval castle and the nearby Wallace monument. On the edge of town is Stirling University's campus where nearly 4,000 international students study.

Friends International's team leader in Stirling is Ivana Bajic, who has been there for six years working with a strong team of volunteers to run Global Café on campus in the university chaplaincy.

In addition, the team run Bible studies, English conversation classes, local link (Friends International's hospitality scheme) and occasional trips.

Friends International is seeking to recruit a Staff Worker (experienced in mission and/or cross-cultural ministry) or Apprentice Staff Worker (willing to be trained) for Stirling, to work with Ivana and the Stirling Branch to fulfil Friends International's mission in the town; working with the church to communicate the good news of Jesus to international students in both word and deed and in whole life cross-cultural discipleship.

Specific responsibilities include:

- Building relationships and sharing faith with international students
- Supporting the Christian Union
- · Working with Ivana to deliver the full range of activities in Stirling
- Developing new ideas to engage a new generation of volunteers and reach out to international students
