Friends international has a well-established international student ministry in the city. In partnership with other missions and volunteers drawn from local churches, the focal point of the ministry is weekly international Cafés which take place in central Manchester and in Salford to provide a loving and safe community for students, where friendships are built, and opportunity is given to explore the Christian faith. Hosting, other social activities, and home Bible studies also take place on a regular basis.

- Being part of the Manchester International Outreach summer team (July).
- Developing new initiatives as agreed with the team leader.

It is expected that the successful candidate will be self-funded or committed to raising their own support.
