



London Profile

London is one of the most multi-cultural cities in the world and hosts more than 200,000 international university students in its 40+ universities and colleges. 25% of the total number of international students coming to the UK to study in HE come to London.

Friends International has had a team in London since its beginning 40 years ago. Given the size of the opportunity FI staff work closely with local churches and other evangelical student ministries, to train, encourage and envision. We have a Philip Project group meeting in London and run Local Link, our hospitality programme. Many of the largest universities are in Central London including UCL, Kings, Imperial, City, LSE, Westminster, and SOAS. Royal Holloway, Roehampton and Kingston are significant players in Southwest London, and Middlesex, Brunel and Westminster Harrow Campus in Northwest London.

Currently we have staff in the Southeast and Northeast of London. We are seeking to grow the team to have staff workers in Central, Southwest and Northwest London. In addition to the general responsibilities of a Friends International Staff Worker (which can be found in the accompanying job description), specific responsibilities of this post include:

- Envisioning, partnering and resourcing churches and Christian Unions for mission among international students with a view to further develop the ministry.
- Assisting in new London-wide ministry developments e.g. London International Summer Outreach, Life Leadership.

There is huge potential to develop international student ministry in London, and we prayerfully look to God for staff who will join the team to help take the work forward.
